Position Summary

AIARE is looking for a full-stack engineer on an hourly or retainer basis to maintain and develop existing database and CRM systems. This is a virtual position as AIARE has no central office, however AIARE employees primarily live and work in the Mountain and Pacific time zone. You will need to be able to work both independently while collaborating virtually, thus be comfortable communicating using a variety of modern technologies and web-based platforms. Working hours are flexible, but you must be able to respond to email and phone calls in a timely fashion and be able to meet firm deadlines.

Responsibilities

The primary responsibilities for this position involve maintaining and developing AIARE's existing database and CRM systems. This includes a Wordpress site, a custom Wordpress plugin, and Airtable apps, automations, and API calls. You will be asked to troubleshoot bugs as they come up, as well as develop new features within the existing system.
